


# MDS Section GG functional Scores

#### 05 - Ind spendent

Complete: the activity by him/hereif with no assistance from a helper

## 05-Setup or dean-up assistance

Helper sets up or deans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

#### 04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal cases and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

#### 03 - Partial/moderate as sistence

Helper doe: LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

### 02 - Substantial/maximal auditance

Helper doe: MORE TIAN HALP the effort. Helper lifts or holdstrunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

#### 01 - Dypenden

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the activity or a complete the activity.

# Outcomes Matter

Mr. Daniel Farmer is a 69-year-old male that was admitted to Park Manor of Conroe after his Hospital stay. He was admitted for Encephalopathy, Humerus Fracture, and needing IV antibiotics.

Our great nursing team worked with Mr.

Farmer and his doctors to knock out his infection and get him back to his motorcycle. Mr. Farmer was promptly evaluated by Physical and Occupational Therapies. He was only able to walk 20 feet with a hemi walker, and needed help to get dressed, move around in bed, and go to the bathroom. He was NWB on his fractured arm so he needed to learn how to accomplish his goals one handed. Daniel worked persistently with all

the therapists to get moving again and fulfill

his goal of going home.

In just 28 days Mr. Farmer was Independently walking 300+ feet with no walker of any kind. He lives on the second floor of his building and was able to work and become independent with 16 stairs. In 41 days, he was able to learn how to independently get dressed, use the bathroom and complete all his ADLs/IADLs with 1 arm. It will still be several weeks before he can use that arm again, but he conquered his goals and was able to return home Independently. He may need rehabilitation again when he has another surgery on his elbow and would not

hesitate to come to Park Manor of Conroe.
