

MDS Section GG functional Scores

06 - Ind opendent

Complete: the activity by him/hereif with no assistance from a helper

05-Setup or dean-up assistance

Helper sets up or deans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal case and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. As sistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

03 - Partial/moderate as skrance

Helper dose LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

02 - Substantial/maximal auditorice

Helper doe: MORE TIAN HALP the effort. Helper lifts or holdstrunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

01 - Dypenden

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
