



MDS Section GG Functional Scores

06 - Independent
Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05- Setup or clean-up assistance
Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance
Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance
Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance
Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent
Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.

OUTCOMES MATTER

Mr. David Heagy is a 68-year-old male that was admitted to Park Manor of Conroe after his Hospital stay. She was admitted for metabolic encephalopathy, and Sepsis.

Our nursing staff looked after the medical issues, so that David could focus on getting stronger. He was quickly evaluated by Physical, Occupational Therapies. He was very debilitated from his hospital stay. He was not able to walk, Max assist to dress himself and move around in bed, and Total Assist for transfers. David worked progressively with all the therapists and in room exercise program to get moving again and fulfill his goal of going home with his family.

In just 27 days Mr. Heagy was able to return home and reached his goals. He is able to walk over 300' independently with a walker, climb 8 stairs and to dress himself. David stated that it was an enjoyable experience and is happy to be going home
